Statement on Per- and Polyfluorinated Alkyl Compounds (PFAS)

Dear Customer,

per- and polyfluorinated alkyl compounds are a group of substances comprising more than 10 000 compounds.

Globally, restrictions on specific PFAS substance groups have been transposed into national law in accordance with the Stockholm Convention. Based on our supplier data, no substances listed in these regulations are present in our articles above their respective threshold limits.

For countries, such as the USA and Canada, where reporting requirements for PFAS substances used or imported have been introduced, Belden provides an overview of products containing globally regulated PFAS according to the current state of knowledge based on material compositions and supplier data.
