- PIP (3:1), phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1), CAS 68937-41-7 (restriction date per originally published final rule: March 8, 2021).
- DecaBDE, decabromodiphenyl ether, CAS 1163-19-5 (restriction date per originally published final rule: January 6, 2021).
- 2,4,6 TTBP, 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol, CAS 732-26-3 (restriction date per originally published final rule: March 8, 2021).
- HCBD, hexachlorobutadiene, CAS 87-68-3, (restriction date per originally published final rule: March 8, 2021).
- PCTP, pentachlorothiophenol, CAS 133-49-3 (restriction date per originally published final rule: March 8, 2021).

Hirschmann products are intended in shape and design for further use or even end use without further modification. As these products are no chemicals or a responsive mixture of chemicals, they are exempt from the declaration obligation and do not need to be declared.
