Montreal Protocol and Regulation (EC) No. 1005/ 2009, (EU) No. 517/ 214 and (EU) 2024/573

Dear Customer,

the Montreal Protocol is a multilateral environmental agreement to protect the ozone layer. The aim of this agreement is to eliminate emissions of halogenated hydrocarbons (HCFCs), chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) and brominated hydrocarbons.

In European law, the Montreal Protocol is implemented by Regulations (EC) No. 1005/ 2009 and (EU) No. 517/ 214.

Belden Deutschland GmbH and Hirschmann Automation and Control GmbH are aware of their responsibility to protect the environment and human health. Therefore, we have always kept on tracking the above-mentioned regulations for updates of new prohibited or restricted substances.
