TSCA Compliance Statement

Under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has banned several chemical substances in whole or in part, particularly if they pose an unreasonable risk to humans and the environment.

The following substances are listed in sections 6(a), 6(h), and 6(e):

- PCBs
- Asbestos
- PIP (3:1) - phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (CAS No. 68937-41-7)
- DecaBDE - decabromodiphenyl ether (CAS No. 1163-19-5)
- TTBP - 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol (CAS No. 732-26-3)
- HCBd - hexachlorobutadiene (CAS No. 87-68-3)
- PCTP - pentachlorothiophenol (CAS No. 133-49-3)

Based on the current verified information of our suppliers, the products of Hirschmann Automation and Control GmbH and Belden Deutschland GmbH **do not contain** substances on the Toxic Substances Control Act Section 6 and its amendments.

Belden Deutschland and Hirschmann products are intended in shape and design for further use or even end use without further modification. As these products are no chemicals or a responsive mixture of chemicals, they are exempt from the declaration obligation and do not need to be declared.
